Emergency Medical Care: If, in our judgment, your dog requires immediate medical care and we are unable to reach you, we will take your dog to a veterinarian or animal hospital.

□ Yes Initials By initialing here, you agree to be solely responsible for the payment of all medical bills for you dog and you release Cody Country Bed & Biscuit, its officers, directors, agents, volunteers, and employees of and from any and all responsibility for, or claims, damages, debts, arising out of or related to such medical care, including, but not limited to, transportation to/from the veterinary clinic and choice of veterinarian and animal hospital.
Cody Country Bed & Biscuit reserves the right to immediately change your dog's type of boarding/daycare if we believe it is necessary to protect the health and well-being of your dog, other dogs, or our staff.
All dogs must be healthy, and current on all vaccinations. You will be required to bring a copy of your dog's updated vaccination records from your vet before you start daycare or board with us to ensure your dog's safety as well as that of our existing Cody Country Bed & Biscuit dogs.
If your dog is exhibiting any symptoms that may suggest illness such as sneezing, coughing, wheezing, runny eyes or nose, vomiting, lethargy, or diarrhea, please do not bring your dog to daycare or boarding. If your dog comes into heat while boarding you will be charged an extra \$25 per day. Dogs with flea or tick problems will be treated with a Capstar tablet, at the owner's expense (\$8 day).
I acknowledge and understand that there are certain risks involved in day care and boarding, including but not limited to dog fights, dog bites to humans or other dogs, and the transmission of disease. Any medical expenses will be my responsibility and I release Cody Country Bed & Biscuit of any charges.
No choke chains, corrective collars, harnesses or clothing allowed in daycare.
All charges must be paid in full upon pick-up of your dog. Dogs left ten days beyond the agreed pick-up date will become property of Cody Country Bed & Biscuit and may be disposed of at the kennel's discretion.
The house brand of dog food is Canidae All Life Stages Dry Food. Changing a dog's food can cause upset stomach, owners are welcomed & encouraged to bring their dog's food from home. Owners are welcome to bring their dog's own bedding or toys if desired, however we cannot guarantee that they will be returned in the same condition.
Pick up/Drop off hours are during regular business hours, unless prearranged and a door security code is assigned, which will require a credit card on file. The credit card on file will be billed the following day after checkout if a security door code is used. Business hours: Monday through Friday 8:00am to 12:00pm / 4:30pm to 6:00 pm. Saturday/Sunday/Holiday 7:30am to 9:00am/ 4:00pm to 5:30pm
We accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, cash, or check (please note, there is a \$25 returned check fee). Payment is due upon pickup of your dog. Cody Country Bed & Biscuit reserves the right, without notice, to adjust its fees for services. Please inquire at the front desk as to our current fees.

Re: Vaccination Requirements

Attention Veterinarians and Pet Care Professionals,

Good Morning!

We at Cody Country Bed & Biscuit have changed our vaccination requirements and hope to clarify to make it easier on both your clinic and customers. These requirements are for dogs who are boarding, training, grooming or using our daycare services. As of last fall, we have changed our CIRD vaccination requirement from standard Bordatella to the "kennel" complex of **Bordatella**, **Adnovirus**, and **Parainfluenza given in the nose**. We do not accept inject-able Parainfluenza in place of nasal application. We do not accept standard Bordatella alone. Should a dog arrive without the complex vaccine, we will have them boosted at the owner's expense.

As of **May 1, 2018** we will require all dogs have **bivalent flu vaccine**. This is a little more involved and expensive so we moved our initial deadline from January 1 to May 1 as we anticipate if we see Flu, it will probably come from out of the area as dogs travel with their owners to visit from regions seeing recent outbreaks. As a social facility, we are at a greater risk of propagating such a virus and wish to avoid it at all costs.

We still honor any circumstances where the vaccine may be more dangerous to a dog such as dogs being treated with chemo drugs or those with autoimmune diseases so long as the owner is willing to sign a waiver expressing their willingness to take responsibility for the risks involved.

We appreciate your time and hope this is something you can offer your customers.
